EPISTLE READING OF THE DAY: This morning's Epistle Reading is from the Second Letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians, chapter 6, verse 16 through chapter 7, verse 1. It is found in our books on page 116.

BUILDING UPDATE: IN ADDITION to a testimonial about WHY people are giving, the most recent building update, with the theme *Building a Legacy*, includes a list of donors to date—269 so far. We thank them for their "gifts of faith." Their names will be inscribed on the dedication wall in the new Cathedral, where prayers will be constantly offered "for the blessed and ever-memorable founders and benefactors of this Holy Church." Meanwhile, 1500 brochures, DVDs and CDs have gone out to potential donors around the country.

MORE GOOD NEWS: The garage walls have all been constructed. Next, the top of the parking structure or, if you prefer, the base of the Cathedral itself (also known as the deck) will be formed. This part of the construction will be going on into autumn.

In the Book of Exodus (25:8) God says: "Build me a Sanctuary, and I will appear among you." (Translated from the Septuagint: Καὶ ποιήσεις μοι ἀγίασμα, καὶ ὁφθήσομαι ἐν ὑμἰν). We've quoted this at least since the start of the Capital Campaign, and we are keeping this "immovable before our eyes," as Deut. 6:8 states. This commandment from Scripture is our vision statement. We can't stress it enough: we're building the Cathedral because God has told us to do so, that His Holy Name may be glorified, in the Orthodox Faith, in this dynamic corridor of San Francisco's inner city! Amazing!

AS OF THIS WRITING, OVER \$5.5 MILLION HAS BEEN RAISED, \$1 MILLION SINCE WE SIGNED THE CONTRACT ON OCTOBER 17, 2013!: The total raised during the Capital Campaign exceeds \$5.5 million. Of the \$5.5 raised, \$4.3 has already been received and \$1.2 million is receivable (from those who are paying over a number of years, in some cases, up to five years.). All from 269 donors, so far. Since you are reading this, let us ask you: Will your name be inscribed on the dedication wall in the new Cathedral, where prayers will be constantly offered "for the blessed and ever-memorable founders and benefactors of this Holy Church?" If not, what are you waiting for?
