## THE 20,000 MARTYRS BURNED AT NICOMEDIA

**EPISTLE READING OF THE DAY:** This morning's Epistle Reading is from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Galatians, chapter 1, verses 11-19. It is found in our books on pages 153.

Ἡκούσατε γὰρ τὴν ἐμὴν ἀναστροφήν ποτε ἐν τῷ Ἰουδαϊσμῷ, ὅτι καθ' ὑπερβολὴν ἐδίωκον τὴν ἐκκλησίαν τοῦ θεοῦ, καὶ ἐπόρθουν αὐτήν· καὶ προέκοπτον ἐν τῷ Ἰουδαϊσμῷ ὑπὲρ πολλοὺς συνηλικιώτας ἐν τῷ γένει μου, περισσοτέρως ζηλωτὴς ὑπάρχων τῶν πατρικῶν μου παραδόσεων. Ὅτε δὲ εὐδόκησεν ὁ θεὸς ὁ ἀφορίσας με ἐκ κοιλίας μητρός μου καὶ καλέσας διὰ τῆς χάριτος αὐτοῦ, ἀποκαλύψαι τὸν υίὸν αὐτοῦ ἐν ἐμοὶ ἵνα εὐαγγελίζωμαι αὐτὸν ἐν τοῖς ἔθνεσιν, εὐθέως οὐ προσανεθέμην σαρκὶ καὶ αἵματι· οὐδὲ ἀνῆλθον εἰς Ἱεροσόλυμα πρὸς τοὺς πρὸ ἐμοῦ ἀποστόλους, ἀλλὰ ἀπῆλθον εἰς Ἁραβίαν, καὶ πάλιν ὑπέστρεψα εἰς Δαμασκόν. Ἔπειτα μετὰ ἔτη τρία ἀνῆλθον εἰς Ἱεροσόλυμα ἱστορῆσαι Πέτρον, καὶ ἐπέμεινα πρὸς αὐτὸν ἡμέρας δεκαπέντε. Ἔτερον δὲ τῶν ἀποστόλων οὐκ εἴδον, εὶ μὴ Ἰάκωβον τὸν ἀδελφὸν τοῦ κυρίου.

It is also the Feast of St. Basil the Great (bishop of Caesarea in Cappadocia, who lived at the beginning of the fourth century. Finally, it is New Year's. Services will be held at the Cathedral as follows: Orthros will begin at 9 a.m., followed by the Divine Liturgy, at 10 a.m.

Usually a sell-out event, the Cathedral's crab feed boasts the best crab around. More importantly, the proceeds support the various philanthropic projects undertaken by the Cathedral Ladies Philoptochos, as well as its support of the rebuilding of the Cathedral.

WE MADE IT TO \$1 MILLION AND BEYOND! Together with the most recent gift to the Capital Campaign of our Ladies Philoptochos, we made it to \$1 million (and beyond). That's a million dollars given and pledged since the October 17, 2013 issuance of our building permit—25 years to the day of Loma Prieta What an accomplishment! If we keep doing this year after year, we will finish and pay off our building in no time.

Meanwhile, the first of two pours of concrete took place on Thursday, December 18. The tension cables have been strengthened to the proper PSI. The second pour of concrete will take place on or about January 5, 2015, thus completing the parking structure ceiling, which is also the Cathedral floor deck. Beginning in mid-January, the vertical steel will start going up. Our goal is to get the parking structure up and running first, as we complete the Cathedral exterior. In the current Herald (as in last month's), we featured photos of the dome steel. We cannot wait for that day to come. However, for all this to happen we need your monetary support and we need your prayers. To date, we have just over 300 donors. This list needs to grow to at least 500. All the donors' names (\$1,000 gift minimum) will eventually be inscribed on the dedication wall in the new Cathedral, where prayers will be constantly offered "for the blessed and ever-memorable founders and benefactors of this Holy Church." We want your children and their children to see your name up on the dedication wall.

In the Book of Exodus (25:8) God says: "Build me a Sanctuary, and I will appear among you." (Translated from the Septuagint: Καὶ ποιήσεις μοι ἀγίασμα, καὶ ὀφθήσομαι ἐν ὑμῖν). We've quoted this at least since the start of the Capital Campaign, and we are keeping this "immovable before our eyes," as Deut. 6:8 states, as we rebuild the Cathedral to God's glory, to serve our faithful and all God's people in this blessed dynamic heart of San Francisco.
